



Citizens Advisory Committee Application

The Santa Clara County Open Space Authority’s mission is to preserve, protect and manage a well-balanced system of urban and non-urban areas of outstanding scenic, recreational and agricultural importance. The Authority’s Board of Directors has established an sixteen-member Citizens Advisory Committee to provide a channel of communication to the Board from the public, aid in fostering a positive public image of the Authority, and help to educate the public about the Authority’s goals and accomplishments. CAC members are appointed for a two-year term and are made up of seven district representatives and nine interest group representatives. District representatives consist of the seven districts that are the boundaries of the voting districts of each of the Directors elected to serve on the Board of Directors. Interest group representatives consist of Agriculture, Community Development, Environmental/Open Space, Parks, Business, Labor, Trails, Civic Organizations, and Education. The CAC meets at 7:00 PM on the 4th Monday of each month, except December.
