



Role of the CAC Member

In establishing the Citizen's Advisory Committee the governing board defined the group's membership based on criteria that would provide a broad representation of interests within the Authority's jurisdiction.

Each member is expected to bring to the group a unique perspective based on the interest area or geographic region he or she represents.

Member Qualifications:

A general knowledge of the subject matter or communities represented and involvement in related activities, preferably within the Open Space Authority boundaries.

Responsibilities:

Read the CAC Handbook, the Open Space Authority 5-Year Plan, and other documentation to become familiar with current issues and their background.

Regularly participate in CAC meetings and subcommittee task groups as established by the CAC and the board.

Attend CAC training sessions, support Open Space Authority at several of the volunteer activities scheduled during the year and attend other meetings as directed.

When speaking in public make clear that you are expressing your own opinions unless you are specifically authorized by the board to represent the Open Space Authority.

Be alert to open space issues, problems and needs that are raised by the community you represent and the general public.
