No. Other than backend website management, website content will be publicly accessible and not behind login walls.
Can you provide more information about the blog/news area of the site? Is there a specific reason for having this on a subdomain? Is this section of your site run by a different CMS? Would you like to bring this section of the site into your main site going forward?
Our blog/news section (news.openspaceauthority.org/blog) is currently managed through HubSpot, which is the agency's Customer relationship management (CRM) platform, and hosted on our website through an API integration with HubSpot. We have no current plans to bring this section into our main site moving forward but are open to ideas, pending future website build.
On your current site when a user clicks on your event calendar, they are taken to Eventbrite. Would you like to keep that set up?
No, we will be phasing out Eventbrite in the coming year and replacing our events management software with Yodel Pass. Our new website will require integration with Yodel Pass rather than Eventbrite.
Will we have access to an image library during the designs process, which includes diverse people using Santa Clara open spaces?
Yes, web designers will have access to the agency's image library, which includes thousands of photos of open space landscapes, preserves, wildlife, plants, and people from diverse backgrounds enjoying nature.
