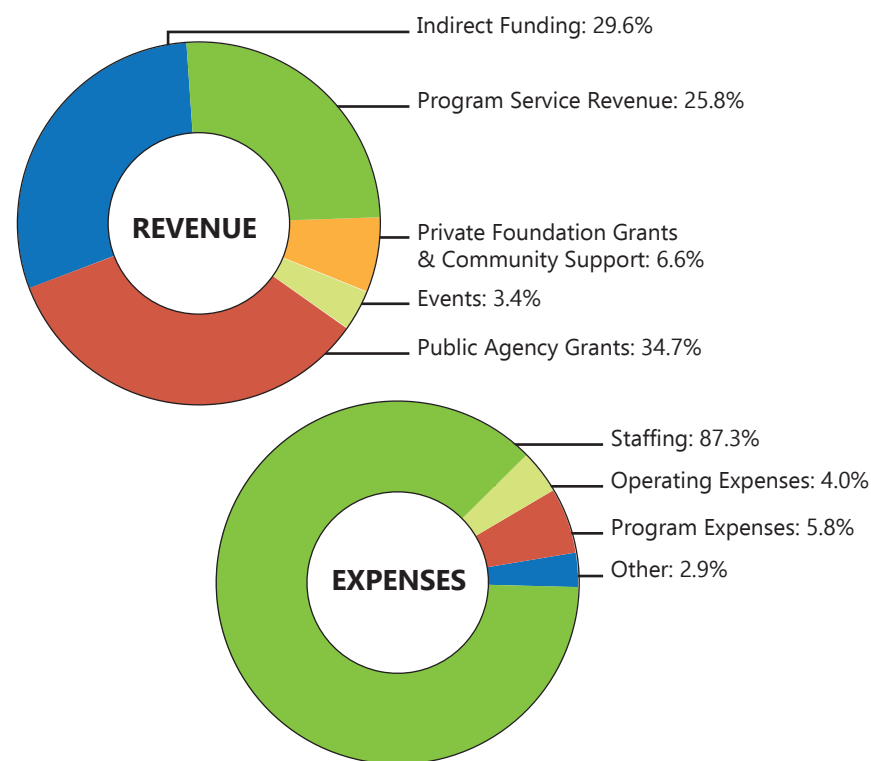

What an amazing year we had! Your support made it possible for Living Classroom's small, but mighty, staff to teach 1600 lessons to 12,100 students in 29 schools last year! Our new schools in Campbell Union surpassed their goal of 300 lessons - we delivered more than 330 lessons at six schools in our first year. Living Classroom also added a pilot program with great success at St. Simon School in Los Altos, that will continue into 2019-20. With your support, we not only achieved the ambitious goals we set for Living Classroom in 2018-19, we exceeded them—thanks to you.

We are humbled and appreciative of the generous support from many funders, especially **El Camino Healthcare District**, the **Santa Clara Valley Open Space Authority** for generous funding to launch the Campbell Union School District Program in 2018-19, **Mountain View Educational Foundation** for ongoing support, and to our Spring Event sponsor, **Google**. In 2019-2020: we will welcome **new** Vargas School in Mountain View Whisman, a new after school program, starting in October, with Santa Clara City Parks and Recreation and a robust Kindergarten - 8th grade program at St. Simon. We are also excited to see our returning students in Palo Alto Unified, Mountain View Whisman, and Campbell Union school districts.

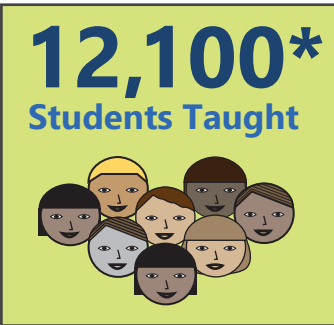

You Helped Us Make a Difference

- Successful launch of Living Classroom's Campbell Union School District program (6 schools; TK/K- 3rd grades)
- A segment of NBC Bay Area's program *Open Road* highlighted Santa Clara Valley Open Space Authority's Measure Q grantees, with Living Classroom's Campbell Union School District program as one of only four featured
- Living Classroom's pilot program at St. Simon School in Los Altos

Highlights

PAUSD

- 166 lessons in 4 schools; Kindergarten–5th grades
- New school this year: Hoover Elementary

- 646 lessons in 10 schools; Transitional Kindergarten–6th grades
- Ancient Civilization lessons piloted in middle school 6th grades
- New gardens installed at Castro, Mistral, Bubb (native garden) and Stevenson schools. Rebuilt gardens at Bubb and Huff schools

CUSD

- 338 lessons in 6 schools; Transitional Kindergarten–3rd grades
- Over 2,000 students, many for the first time, planted a plant in their school garden.
- Special Day Classes at Lynhaven School joined their corresponding grade classrooms as part of Living Classroom's Inclusion Program
- New gardens installed at Capri, Rosemary, Lynhaven and Sherman Oaks schools

St. Simon School

- Piloted 12 lessons in 6 grades in Spring 2019
- 10 beds installed for student use by school and parish community
