

Citizens' Advisory Committee Application

The Open Space Authority conserves the natural environment, supports agriculture and connects people to nature, by protecting open spaces, natural areas, and working farms and ranches for future generations.

The Authority's Board of Directors has established a thirteen member Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) with the purpose of providing many avenues of input to and from the Open Space Authority's diverse communities and to help foster a positive public image of the agency. Serving two-year terms, members provide a broad representation of interest within the Authority's jurisdiction. The committee is made up of seven District Representatives and six At large Representatives. CAC District Representatives serve each of the seven districts that correspond to the Authority Board Districts. The CAC District Representative brings a perspective from his/her Authority District to the deliberations of the CAC and must reside within the represented area. The CAC At large representative shall be able to demonstrate a general knowledge of and involvement in the activities of at least one priority interest area that supports the Authority Board's focus for the CAC. These areas may include, but are not limited to Agriculture, Business, Civic Organizations, Development Community, Parks, Public Health and Safety and/or Trails. The CAC meets at 7:00 PM on the 4th Monday of every other month, except December.
