Addendum No.2 consists of –

The Authority received the following questions for RFP-2022-12: Coyote Valley Sobrato South Grazing License by the September 21, 2022 deadline.

Question 1:

Is farming and tilling allowed?

Yes, dry farming is allowed with prior permission each year. Tilling is also allowed. Hay that is harvested on site must be used for cattle in Coyote Valley.

Question 2:

Will fence line be on the boundary line. Can we have 20' gates?

Fence line will be on the property boundary line. We can work with the grazer selected for gate placement. Gates will be 20' wide to allow for farming equipment.

Question 3:

Can we add troughs?

Yes.

Question 4:

Are there corrals?

No.

Question 5:

Is there a list of herbicides we can't use?
